- **22% for SC and 6% for ST, \***

\*As per Government rule **Scheduled Caste** and **Scheduled Tribe** and **other Backward Class** candidates in her domicile state are entitled to get the **reservation facility**. SC/ST certificate issued by the competent authority of Government of West Bengal are only accepted.

A Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe student getting admission should obtain marks in the previous qualifying examination in the relevant Honours subject not lower than **25%** than that obtained by the last candidate admitted from the General Category.
