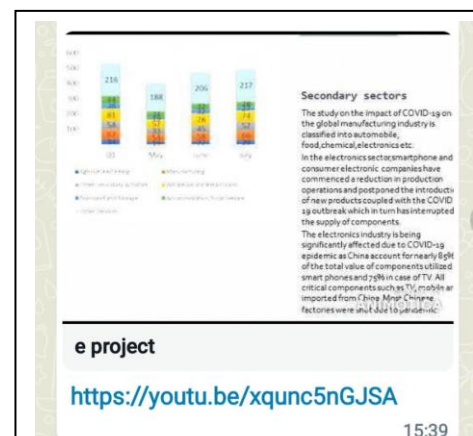

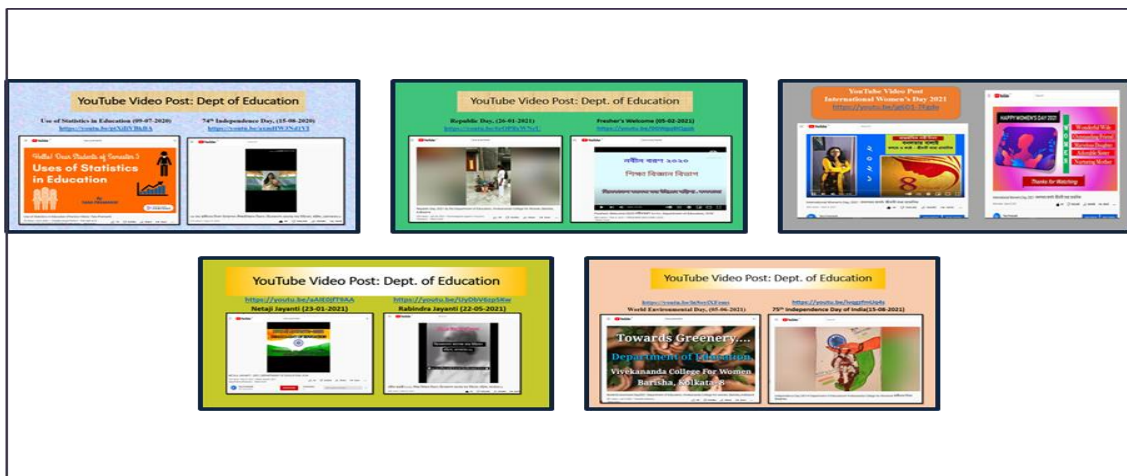

With a focus to restore our earth, students presented their original thoughts through the painting medium, through visual representation and self-composed poems. They uploaded their programme in you tube platform.



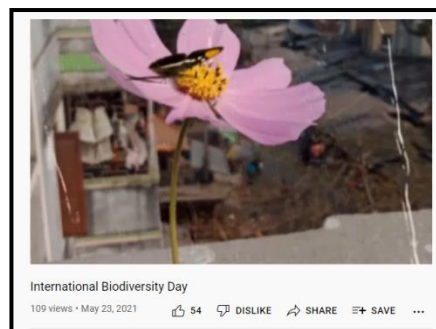
## Rabindrajayanti 2021

took a pledge to preserve biodiversity as a team member bearing positive thought of they celebrated the day.

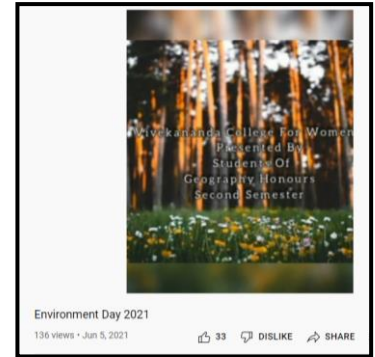

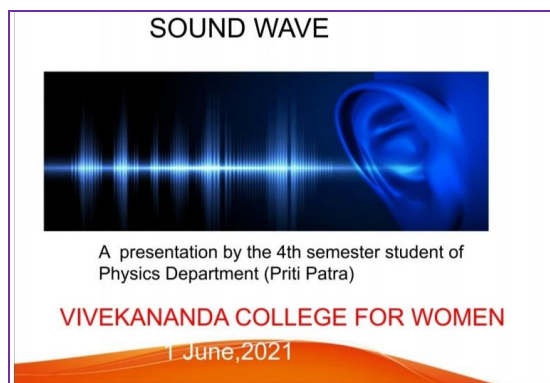
- **Intra-College Online Quiz Competition**

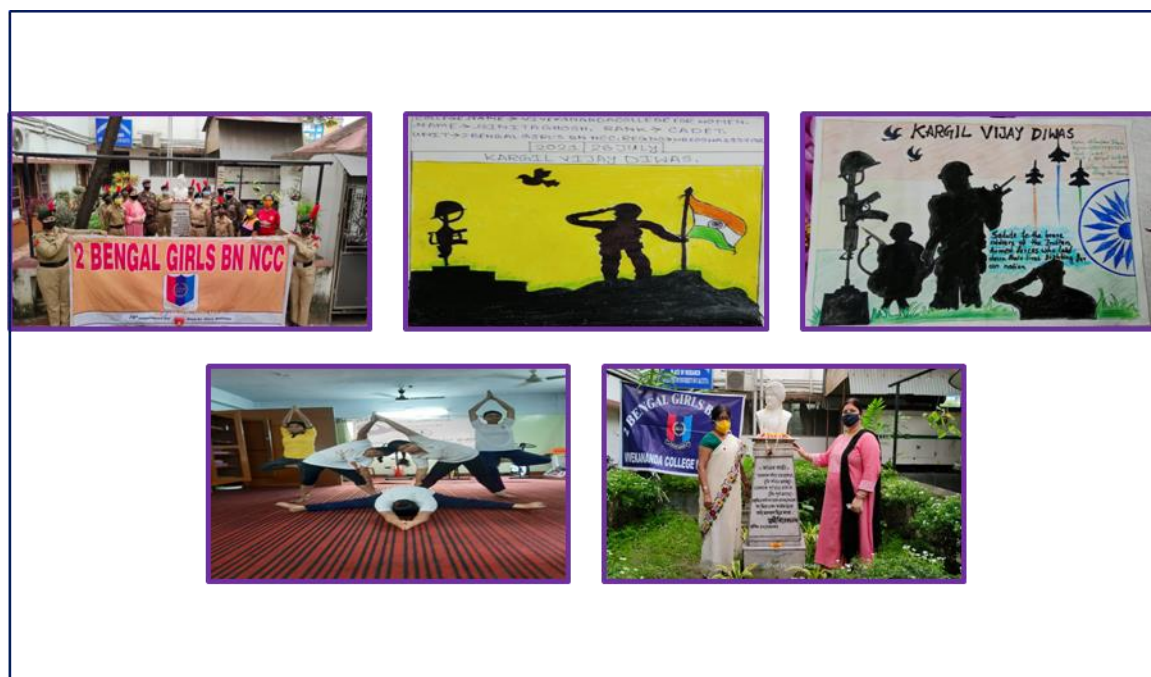

## **Report of Career Counselling Cell (2020-21)**

Career Counselling cell of this college was established in 2007 for imparting job oriented training to students and make them better equipped to enter the job market. The Cell also has been working towards dissemination of information regarding various career opportunities.

During the period under consideration, all activities of the College were held in online mode. Accordingly, The Career Counselling Cell operated in online platform. The activities included training programmes as well as career guidance sessions.

An online Career Counselling session was organised during the period 3/08/2020-7/08/2020. Ms.SaswatiMukhopadhyay , Joint Director of Employment, Government of West Bengal conducted the session. The purpose of this session was to guide students in respect of choosing a suitable career. Around 12 students participated in this session.

A team (led by Ms.MadhupaBakshi, Dean) from the department of Media Science, Heritage College, Kolkata, conducted an online Personality Development Programme during the period 12/08/2020 -23/09/2020. Number of participants was approximately 15.

A webinar was organised on 14/06/2021 in collaboration with RICE Education Society, a leading institute for imparting training for competitive examinations.
